


ERASMUS+ Teachers questionnaire

To know other persons with similar expectations



Students will become more targeted, Increasing openness, communication skills.



Did the project activities come to fulfill your expectations?




Yes -100% No – 0%

Helping them create an English CV.


I think it's always important, especially in sharing the results.

It is a great opportunity to know the ways of doing other educational centers. It has been very helpful for me to be able to share talks with other teachers and visit their work centers.


Knowledge and skills in social sciences.
